April 27, 2022

Call to Order

Workman called the meeting to order at 5:38 p.m. and confirmed compliance with the Open Meeting Law. Motion by Gabrielson, second by Hartup, to approve the minutes of the April meeting. Motion carried.

New Business

a. Jackson property update

Workman gave a summary of the 4/23 trail building progress update; there was no progress on the naming front yet. Workman said a 0.2 mi loop almost completely done, and another 0.4 mile marked and mostly cut, minus the two creek crossings. **Workman will make a Google sheet to track volunteer hours to share with BAG members/volunteers to track hours for volunteer work** (good for “match” of time/labor on grants). **Workman will provide Wildside with COB volunteer waivers.**

d. Discussion of Bike to Work Day (5/20) event

Current plan for **Friday, May 20 - Bike to Work/School event:** 7 am set up for bike tent in Nanny Park, take down at 8 am. Rich from Coffee Bean will provide complimentary coffee. Wildside will provide the tent. Neatos bakery has not gotten back to Taft about donating donuts. Taft will get on social media feeds of Downtown Baraboo, Inc., in the coming week. **Taft will write the press release to the Baraboo News Republic, create a flyer, and maybe a one minute video.** **Taft will send a flyer to all BAG members to print and post at places of interest (BHS, Wildside); Taft will distribute flyers to downtown businesses.**

Hartup asked what the social interaction will be if it's a few adults (us) and some kids. Gabrielson suggested contacting teachers; Workman said Harding reported via email she has reached out to principals of schools. Taft said through DBI he may be able to purchase a few cases of water, maybe donut holes for kids. **Robinson will provide literature on the mountain bike team.** **Hartup will peruse literature from Bike Fed to provide.**
